In addition to the above VSQG collection days, 18 businesses dropped off 6,762 pounds of hazardous waste at the Spooner storage site in 1996. In 1997, 34 businesses dropped off 7,116.5 pounds, and 7,199 more pounds were picked up from 4 business locations.
